












IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS



# First make sure power is turned off!

- 1. Prepare and assemble CANOPY KIT.
- 2. Securely mount the fixture hardware provided as illustrated in the instructions.
- 3. Prepare fixture for wiring.
- 4. Connect AC supply and ground as labeled on the provided wire leads. Insulate unused wire! CAUTION! Failure insulate unused wire may result in a shock hazard or unsafe condition as well as equipment failure. Route wires and secure them in place. 5. Turn on AC.



# AIRCRAFT CABLE KIT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Install the 1/4-20 screw in the cross bar.
- 2. Install cross bar to junction box.
- 3. Assemble power cord and strain relief through the canopy hole.
- 4. Slip the aircraft cable in the coupler.
- 5. Depress the lock ring on the cable gripper.
- 6. Install the cable in the cable gripper (note the lock ring must be loose).
- 7. Adjust to the appropriate height and release the lock ring on the gripper.
- 8. Place the canopy over the top of the coupler and install on the ½-20 screw in the cross bar (by loosening the lock ring on the coupler the canopy will move up and down the cable).
- 9. Connect the power cable in accordance to all codes and labels.
- 10. Move the canopy in place and tighten the lock ring on the coupler to the desired position.
- 11. Install and trim wire ties as desired.

# PENDANT KIT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:


- 1. Connect all wiring in the j-box (provided by others) in accordance with all codes and labels.
- 2. Install cross bar to junction box.
- 3. Fasten (1) lock nut on end of stem.
- 4. Fasten stem into cross bar.
- 5. Feed wires through stem.
- 6. Attach cross bar assembly to j-box.
- 7. Slip canopy (flange up) onto stem.
- 8. Slide slip ring up stem and use set screw to hold in place.
- 9. Attach stem to fixture using one lock nut on top.
- 10. Adjust slip ring to tighten canopy to ceiling or desired position.








# **SWIVEL CANOPY KIT**
